



## Family Battle Plan

A discipleship pathway to assist parents in engaging their children on their journey of faith

### **Week 1: Creation**

#### Younger Preschool

##### **Theme Verse**

*“Then God said, ‘Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness. They will rule the fish of the sea, the birds of the sky, the livestock, the whole earth, and the creatures that crawl on the earth’” (Genesis 1:26).*

##### **Objective**

God made people.

##### **Teach**

Maintain close proximity, stay at eye level, show enthusiasm, and incorporate movement whenever possible.

*Question 1 “Johnny, who made you? God made YOU!”*

*(Pause after answering “God made...” then point to or pick up your child with enthusiasm and say “YOU!!” Add the names of family members close by.)*

*Question 2 “Johnny, who does God love? God LOVES you!”*

*(State “LOVES!” with excitement paired with a hug and add on the names of family members close by.)*

##### **Discussion Questions**

Review and repeat the two questions to reiterate the truth to your younger preschooler that God made them and He loves them.

## **Play**

Peekaboo, God made you!

Similar to peek-a-boo, hold a blanket in between you and your child and ask “Who made you?” Pulling it away say “God made you!”

## **Live it Out**

Carrying over from the peek-a-boo game, tell your child “God made you and He loves you! God gave me you and I love you!” Throughout the week, play the peek-a-boo game to remind your child that God created them and He loves them.
